Principal report (Mrs. Gomez) -High number of attendance at Meet the Teacher night. Teachers were asked to send a welcome
letter to families.
-As per Alberta Education, Grades 1-3 had screening, this helps teachers know where students are at.
-Thank you families for donating to the Terry Fox run. Due to the large numbers, teachers decided when was an appropriate time for their class to go.

-Last Thursday staff had PD sessions; one session focused on how to communicate assessments to families. New program for SpacesEDU, (live portfolios) Portfolios document the progress of students' learning throughout the year; some will be receiving online portfolios as some teachers are learning new technology.

-Bylaw officer came out and will continue to come out periodically for unlawful parking. Today warnings were given out but no tickets.

-The school continues to grow, we are at 1312. Portables are coming and the estimated date that students will be moved in is January. The new portables will help to alleviate some of the high class sizes.

-The fenced area will be a new parking lot for the staff. Currently half of the staff are parking on the streets, this new parking lot will help to alleviate some of the traffic congestion.

-A couple parents expressed that the traffic is very congested going in and out of Desrochers. Mrs. Gomez encouraged parents to call 311 to advocate for another route into Chapelle.

-A parent asked about the new Catholic school and the timeline. Two new Catholic schools will be built in Cavanagh and Hays Ridge, estimated time is approximately two years from now.

Alberta School council engagement grant (\$500 this year)

This grant can be used for activities and projects for parent involvement, learning, resources, etcc. Any ideas for how to best use this grant are encouraged, and will be discussed at our next meeting.
